



SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS 2018

Notice is hereby given that Waterford City and County Council in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act 2004, has adopted Waterford City and County Council Special Speed Limit (Amendment) Bye-Laws 2018 for the administrative area of Waterford, following a review of specific speed limits in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport for the application of speed limits.

The purpose of these bye-laws is to make amendments to the Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2017 in the interests of prudent traffic management and road safety as set out below.

- R680 Kilmeaden/Doneen - re-location of the 50km/h special speed limit nearer to Kilmeaden.
- L907-08 Monamintra Cross Road and L907-06 Kilcaragh Cross Road - change to the current speed limit of 80 km/h to 50 km/h.

These bye-laws will come into operation with effect from **16th July, 2018**. These bye-laws and the Waterford City and County Council Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2017 may be cited together as the Waterford City and County Council Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2017 to 2018.
