



PROPOSED PART-TIME PEDESTRIANISATION OF APPLEMARKET/ LOWER JOHN STREET

Notice is hereby given that Waterford City and County Council propose to restrict vehicular access to the following road, **from 5th June 2018**.

Road to be closed:

- Applemarket/Lower John Street, Waterford.
 - Monday to Saturday – closed to traffic from 6.00pm to 7.00am
 - Sunday/Public Holidays – closed to traffic all day, reopening at 7.00am Monday

Vehicular access will be restricted to the Applemarket by automated barriers located at the lower end of John Street. Residents of Spring Garden Alley, Parnell Street (with access via Spring Garden Alley) or Lady Lane will continue to have 24 hour access and the Council has written to all residents in this regard.
