1. SECTION 38 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994 – Traffic Calming Scheme along L4033 Brown Street, Portlaw – Completion of Process

G. Hynes, SE, outlined the details of the traffic calming scheme along the L4033, Brown Street in Portlaw Village. The works will include upgrade and modification of existing footpaths, designate parking, provide build outs, uncontrolled crossing points, controlled crossing points, raised tables with improved road markings and the provision of new public lighting, as set out on the attached drawing. The main goal is to reduce vehicular speed and to provide safe access and connectivity by way of footpaths and crossing points along Brown Street. The implementation of the traffic calming scheme will create a safe environment for all road users with a strong emphasis on non-motorized road users. Members were informed that one submission was received and recommended the scheme as advertised for their approval.

Proposed by Cllr. Clune, noting the scheme will slow down traffic on the road and improve the way cars are parked and improve the quality of the footpaths, scheme is very welcomed by the residents. Seconded by Cllr. Power who welcomed the level of work that is being carried out in Portlaw. Cllr. Barron complimented the roads section on all the work being carried out in villages across the district, these schemes are significantly improving facilities. Cathaoirleach welcomed the scheme, noting it as another positive development for the village of Portlaw and adding to all the works delivered in the village to date.

Scheme was passed unanimously.

G. Hynes, SE noted that the next stage will be to go out to tender and will positively improve the village of Portlaw.
