1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strengthening and surface dressing works near completion on Local and Regional roads throughout the District. • Jet Patcher in District as per machinery yard's programme.
2.	<p><u>OPW Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consultant appointed for Erosion Risk Management Study in Ardmore as per OPW requirements.
3.	<p><u>Coastal Repair Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Procurement completed and award of contract imminent for Ballinacourty Pier €70,000. • Works at Helvick Pier completed - €200,000.
4.	<p><u>TII Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funding applications approved for pavement overlay schemes at N25 Ticknock - €200,000 and N25 Ballybrusa/Ferryport - €200,000. – Procurement completed and contract award imminent. Works at N25 Ticknock will require 2 day road closure to lay Hot Road Asphalt as there are no hardshoulders and sideway safety zone cannot be achieved. This will be advertised. N25 Ballybrusa/Ferryport will be stop/Go traffic management as there are hardshoulders. • Funding applications approved to deal with defective road surface - €50,000 and footpaths - €50,000 in Cappoquin. Procurement finalised and works completed to footpath and surfacing works imminent at Cappoquin.

6.	<p><u>CLAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knockanore Traffic Calming - €49,500–Section 38 approved and works underway. • Approval recently received for Villierstown €49,500 and Aglish €49,500.
7.	<p><u>Low Cost Schemes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dromana €60,000 - height restriction measures to prevent arch being struck at bridge – signage design being finalised. • Tallow at Grotto €30,000. Works are imminent.
8.	<p><u>Section 38's</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Section 38 advertised for Villierstown providing connectivity from existing footpath at junction (road from Woodview Estate) to existing footpath in Main Street and on agenda for September meeting.
9.	<p><u>Climate Adaption Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DTTAS Climate Adaption Tourin (DL 2021) - €200,000 – Rock armour works underway at embankment,
10.	<p><u>Active Travel</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Villierstown – Footpath completed on road near Villierstown School. Surfacing to junction near completion. Section from junction towards Quay road surfacing is imminent. • Aglish - kerbing/footpath/public lighting proposal in front of houses near completion. Surfacing to follow. • Garranbane –Drainage, ducting and boundary wall completed. Kerbing, public lighting near completion. Surfacing to follow. • Ballinroad village –Drainage and kerbing completed. Gully work required beyond Knocknagranagh estate and surfacing will follow. • Crossbridge Street –Section of footpath paved up to post office. Road Surfacing to follow. • O'Connell Street - paving footpaths completed and concreting section of footpath underway. • An Rinn –Kerbing/footpath near completion. • Ardmore – Works underway for footpath and pedestrian crossing with Belisha beacon as per Section 38. Works near completion. • Ardmore – footpath to GAA field – Communications ongoing with landowner. • Knockanore -Section 38 approved and works underway.

11.	<p><u>Other works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dungarvan North –Drainage and Road repairs ongoing in Colligan, Kilmurray, Kilgobnet, Lackendarra, Ballinroad, Glenbeg, Dungarvan and Environs. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Lismore West –Drainage and Road repair works at Lismore area, Glencairn, Glendine, Knockanore, Ballyduff, Ballysaggart and Tallow areas. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Lismore East –Drainage and road repair works in Cappoquin Area, Moneygorm, Clashmore, Aglish, Dromana, Villierstown and Melleray area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Dungarvan South - Drainage and road repair works underway in Glenbeg, Old Parish, Ballybrusa, An Rinn, Grange and Ardmore area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing.
12.	<p><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Road lining ongoing throughout the District. • Outdoor dining – Section 254 Licence required from Planning Department. • Installation of Bike stands for car parks and any appropriate location on work programme. • Bollards installed around bike stand in Ardmore completed. • Signage regarding HGV on Chapel Street, Tallow on work programme. • Works to increase length of driver testing Bay on Walsh Street underway. • Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages. • Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying. • Hedgecutting is now permitted to end of February. Landowners should continue to check and cut their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads that may cause road safety issue. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. • Cycle signs being installed at locations throughout District informing drivers to give cyclist Space – 1.5m and 1.0m as required. • N72 road resurfacing works from Ballylemon to Cappagh completed. • N72 Lismore/Ballyrafter traffic calming scheme works underway.
