1. Road Works Programme

The Road Works Programme (RWP) 2021 Macadam tender was advertised on the 12th March 2021. On the closing date the 9th of April 2021 a total of three tenders were received. The preferred tender was submitted by Roadstone Limited and they have now been awarded this Contract. Works are scheduled to commence in the City at the end of June. The Machinery Yard strengthening works in the Metro District started at the end of May with surface dressing to commence in June. Drainage works included on the RWP 2021 will also commence in the coming weeks.

2. Community Involvement schemes

Currently no CIS scheme planned in the Metro District for 2021.

3. Low Cost Safety Schemes

The following is a list of schemes for which funding approval has been submitted for 2021 in the Metropolitan District:

- i. Ballinattin on the R685 improvement works to junction land to be acquired.
- ii. Footpath and pedestrian crossing completion at Quarry Road to be confirmed as funding from Active travel may be made available for completion of this work.
- iii. Killea Road Dunmore East Completion of footpath works.

4. Coastal Repair works

A detailed application for funding was made for 2021 to the Department of Agriculture Food and Marine to approve further funding for coastal repair works at Tramore Pier and in addition funding for works to carry out repairs at Cheekpoint Pier. This funding was confirmed in May and work has now commenced to appoint a design consultant and commence preparation of Contract Documents so these repair works can be tendered.

5. Road Closures

There was a temporary road closure on the L- 4049 at Butlerstown in May to facilitate replacement of a damaged culvert.

6. Other Works

Tramore Area

- Pothole repairs in the around Tramore town at various locations, at Newtown, on Dunhill Road, on L-4049 Ballycashin, on the L-4050 Butlerstown, on Priests Road, An Garran, Ard na Groi, Ard na Ghlenna, An Cairn, the L-8038 Kilbride, the L-8034 Carrigavantry and Lower Prom car park.
- The Council Jet Patcher was working on the L-4054 Kilfarrasy, the L4055 Garrus and the L-8030 beach road Kilfarrassy.
- Drainage works on the Kilbride Road, on the L-4054 Garrus, the L-4054 Kilfarrasy, in Pine Grove and on the R675 at Pickardstown.
- Contractor replacing collapsed culvert on the L-4050 Butlerstown.
- Footpath works in Roselawn and on the Waterford Road.

- Illegal dumping cleared from Green Road, Carrigavantry, the L4049 Ballycashin and the L8038 Kilbride.
- Removing graffiti at Ballycarnane.
- Clearing seaweed from Tramore Pier.
- Repair works carried out to storm manhole in Beech Estate.
- Repairs to ground in Ard na Ghlenna estate behind an unused chamber.
- There were four out of hours callouts during the month of May 2021 due to fallen tree, issues with barriers and drainage.

Dunmore Area

- Velocity Jet Patcher working on the L-4079 Dromina to Drumrusk, the L-4080 Barristown to Ballyvoreen and the L-8053 Ballynamoyntragh.
- Pothole repairs carried out on the L-8039 Castletown, the L-4068 Coxtown to Clohernagh, the L-4076 Kilmacomb to Woodstown and the L-8053 Orchardstown.
- Bin collections have increased to three times during the week and also at weekends due to extra public activity around the towns and beaches in the Area.
- Drainage works and opening inlets on the L-8048 Kilmaquague, the L-8053 Keiloge and the L-40751 Creadan.
- Footpath repairs on the Killea Road at Marian Terrace.
- Ongoing works side cleaning and inlets in preparation for RPS Strengthening and Surface Dressing works.
- There was one out of hours callout during May 2021 in Metro East Area due to fallen trees.

Waterford City:
