Roads Act 1993 – Section 73

Extinguishment of Public Right of Way over

Section of Pier Head Road, Ferrybank, Waterford.

In pursuance of its function under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993 Waterford City and County Council proposes to extinguish the public right of way over a Section of Pier Head Road, Ferrybank, Waterford. The proposal was advertised for public consultation in the Munster Express on 11th August, 2020 and a Site Notice was also placed at the location. The deadline for submissions was 21st September, 2020, however none were received.

The public right of way being extinguished refers to a distance of approximately 83m to a section of Pier Head Road which extends in a north to south direction from the northern side of the level crossing of the Waterford to Rosslare railway line to the end of the former Pier which is now incorporated in the Frank Cassin Wharf as indicated on the attached drawing. The public right of way is being extinguished to reflect the

non use of this section of Pier Head Road in recent decades.

Your approval to the making of an Order pursuant to Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993 to extinguish the road as advertised, is recommended for approval.
