Traffic Calming Scheme - Pedestrian Crossing Cois Trá, Ardmore L2107

Waterford City & County Council advertised the following proposal from Wednesday 1st July to Tuesday 28th July, 2020 with a closing date for submissions up to 4.00 pm on Tuesday 11th August, 2020. No submissions were received.

Details of the proposal are to undertake the construction of a macadam raised table in Ardmore from existing footpath outside the Tourist office towards the Playground. The proposal is a traffic calming measure including a raised pedestrian crossing as set out below. The proposal will provide a safe crossing point for all users.

Works Requirements

Raised Pedestrian Crossing extending from playground to Pedestrian area (L-2107)
i.e. 3m wide platform & 2 x 1m tapers either side

- 50mm SMA (10mm macadam)
- 75mm AC 20 Dense Bin 70/100 des binder course
- AC14 regulating course – varied thickness

Your approval to proceed with the works as set out above is requested.
