ROADS PROGRESS REPORT MARCH 2023

A. Roads Works Programme 2023

The Roads Works Programme for 2023 – Local road strengthening works have commenced. Surface dressing and regional road strengthening will be scheduled for later in the year.

B. Road Maintenance Works

The District area crews have been continuously filling potholes and repairing roads. Road repairs (potholes and damaged edges) and drainage discretionary works will continue to take place under the Maintenance budgets.

C. Active Travel Measures

The Comeragh District has been allocated in funding for the following projects:

- Portlaw Village Footpath replacement (George Street) -in construction
- Carrick Road Urban Connectivity Works, Portlaw €640,000 Contract awarded. Construction to commence February.
- Brown Street L4033 Design and construction €200,000 Section 38 Process approved.
 Tender stage completed and contract awarded.
- R681 Main Street, Kill Village Pedestrian Crossing and speed table, footpath link €120,000— Construction works close to completion.
- Rathgormack village centre footpath link €40,000 Works completed.

F. Mahon Falls Car Park & Lay bys Development

Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure Scheme (ORIS), Measure 2 recently announced €200,000 funding by the Minister for Rural and Community Development for the proposed extension to an existing car park at Mahon Falls trailhead and additional lay bys along the local road L3047 with the enhancement to the existing lay bys to allow for safe passing. ABP has approved planning with amendments as submitted in with further information.

Works ongoing, main car park construction almost completed.

G. Mahon Bridge Car Park

Part 8 planning approved. Consultant appointed to prepare tender documentation and expected to go out to tender March 2023.

H. Fishery Harbour and Coastal Infrastructure Development Programme 2022-2023

The Department of Agriculture, Food and Marine for Harbours, Piers and Slipways improvement as part of the Brexit Adjustment Local Authority Marine Infrastructure Scheme 2022-2023 approved the following scheme:

Boatstrand Pier North & West Side Construct storm wall and installation of new public lighting - €164,008 – Storm wall tender assessment underway and public lighting is being designed.

- Stormwall works are completed.
- Lighting design underway.

J. Clár

In July 2022, the department announced projects which secured funding under Clár Measures 1 - Development of Community facilities and amenties within the Comeragh Area.
