9. Active Travel

- Progression of works will depend on funding approval from NTA.
- Active Travel preparing schemes for Collins Road.
- Cluain Garabhain/Tournore Active Travel works by District including civil, drainage, footpath pedestrian crossing installation and surfacing completed. Landscaping works to be completed.
- Aglish Drainage and foopath works ongoing.
- Ballinroad Communications with landowners regarding land requirements for the section 38 approved scheme.
- Ardmore Footpath to GAA field agreement with solicitor for signing.
- Knockanore landowner agreement with solicitor for final sign off.
- An Rinn Active Travel works by District including civils, drainage, ducting, kerbing, pedestrian crossing paving, public lighting and pedestrian crossing installations and surfacing completed. Traffic calming build outs completed.
- Ballyduff Upper works completed to footpath construction, pedestrian crossing works including drainage works and signs installation. Surfacing underway.

10. Other works

- Dungarvan North road repairs ongoing at Dungarvan, Colligan, Ballinroad, Knockanpower, Kilnafrehan, Ballylemon and Environs. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Works underway at Coolnasmear bridge.
- Lismore West drainage and road repair works at Lismore area, Ballyduff area, Knockanore and Tallow area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing.
- Lismore East drainage and road repair works in Villierstown, Cappoquin Area, Clashmore, Aglish and environs. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Active travel works ongoing in Aglish.
- Dungarvan South drainage and road repair works underway in An Rinn, Grange, Ballybrusa and Ardmore area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing.

ROADS PROGRESS JANUARY REPORT 2023

- Following low temperatures and heavy rainfall events there is an increase in potholes. Crews are dealing with potholes in the District. Continue to report on CRM and to District Engineer. Potholes will be filled as soon as possible.
- Road lining ongoing throughout the District.
- Davitt Quay –further cobble lock repairs underway.
- Litter and dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages.
- Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying.
- Hedgecutting is now permitted until end of February. Landowners should continue to check their boundary hedges and trees in front of public roads that may cause road safety issues. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. Section 70 Notices being issued to non-compliant landowners.
