9.	<p><u>Climate Adaption Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DTTAS Climate Adaption Tourin (DL 2021) - €200,000 – Rock armour works completed at embankment.
10.	<p><u>Active Travel</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tallow – Section 38 works underway on construction of footpaths. Villierstown – Section from junction towards Quay road surfacing will be completed by machinery yard. Aglish – Surfacing, kerbing/footpath/public lighting proposal in front of houses completed. Garranbane – Kerbing, Drainage, ducting and boundary wall completed. Public lighting near completion. Surfacing to follow when trench settlement is sufficient. Ballinroad village – drainage and kerbing completed. Surfacing at junction near church to be completed. Crossbridge Street – section of footpath paved up to post office. Road Surfacing completed. O’Connell Street- Paving footpaths completed and concreting section of footpath to junction with shopping centre completed. An Rinn –Kerbing/footpath near completion. Surfacing works underway. Ardmore – Works for footpath and pedestrian crossing with Belisha beacon completed. Surfacing to follow. NTA Outdoor fund – Ardmore €40,000 – Extending section of existing footpath to Ardmore beach and road surfacing. Kerbing and footpath completed. Surfacing to follow. Ardmore – footpath to GAA field – Communications ongoing with landowner. Knockanore - footpath works underway. Landtake maps underway. Lismore - kerbing and footpath proposal for Deerpark road within proximity of school on works programme. Ballyduff – Section 38 being finalised in accordance with active travel’s requirements. Replacing bike stands at Clonea beach completed.

Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Dungarvan South - Drainage and road repair works underway in Ballybrusa, Old Parish, Liskeelty, An Rinn, Grange and Ardmore area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing.
12	<p>Item Raised/Other Works</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • R675 Kilminnin road closure advertised from Monday 22nd November to 10th December to facilitate drainage works. • Road lining ongoing throughout the District. • Outdoor Dining – Section 254 Licence required from Planning Department. • Installation of Bike stands for car parks will be placed at appropriate locations. • Wheelchair assessable table ordered for Ardmore and Dungarvan. • Signage regarding HGV on Chapel Street, Tallow on work programme. • Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages. • Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying. • Hedgecutting is now permitted to end of February. Landowners should continue to check and cut their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads that may cause road safety issues. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. • Cycle signs being installed at locations throughout District informing drivers to give cyclist Space – 1.5m and 1.0m as required. • N72 Lismore/Ballyrafter traffic calming scheme works underway. Stop/Go traffic management in place.
