Town Village Renewal Scheme 2021

Up to 8 applications per Local Authority – €1.45m maximum per LA; Waterford preparing 8 applications to be submitted for funding; currently finalising costings for final submissions to the DRCD by 16th July 2021.

3. Waterford Trails

The new Walk Waterford-From Sea to Mountains booklet along with an accompanying online resource www.visitwaterfordtrails.com with new trail mapping, videos and images was launched by Mayor of Waterford City & County Council, Cllr. Joe Kelly at the beautiful Anne Valley Walk recently. These new promotional resources have been prepared by Waterford City & County Council and funded by the Department of Rural and Community Development under the Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure Scheme. The launch coincides with what will no doubt be a very busy summer season for outdoor recreation in Waterford.

Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure Scheme (ORIS) 2019:

Work substantially progressed under all ORIS 2019 projects. Remaining Measure 1 and 2 projects to be complete by 31st August 2021 (following extension granted by DRCD due to Covid restriction related delays).

- Measure 1: EuroVelo Cycle Route and Waterford Cycling Trails signage upgrade works; Signage substantially complete
- Measure 2: Anne Valley Walk works. Part VIII approved at June Comeragh MD meeting. Currently at procurement stage.

ORIS 2020

Trail improvement works at Nire Valley Walks and Boolas Walk (Rathgormack) funded under ORIS 2020 currently at tendering stage.

ORIS 2021-Measure 1:

- Application for €20,000 submitted on 30th June in relation to upgrade of Cleireach's Bothairín (Cleary's Boreen), Portlaw.
- Application for €17,370.00 submitted on 30th June in relation to development of Waterford Trails promotional resources.

4. Tourism

Visitor Experience Development Plan for Rural Waterford 2021-2023

Waterford City and County Council has launched the "Rural Waterford Visitor Experience Development Plan 2021-2023" and an accompanying app for mobile devices called "The **Explore More Waterford** App". Both have been jointly funded by the Department of Rural & Community Development, under the Town & Village Renewal Scheme (Covid-19 Accelerated Measure), and Waterford City & County Council in conjunction with the Local Flavours Interreg programme. The Local Flavours programme seeks to support smaller, more rural areas to fully maximise the potential of their unique culture and heritage.



The Visitor Experience Development Plan aims to identify existing and potential compelling experiences that bring rural Waterford to life. It builds on the Interreg Local Flavours ethos of delivering memorable moments to visitors. It aims to increase the dispersion and numbers of visitors to the towns and villages of rural Waterford seeking to increase tourism revenue in a sustainable way. It supports a sustainable rural economy based on low-impact activity tourism and the harnessing of collaborative investment and support.
