Surfacing to follow during school closure.</li> <li>• Ballinroad village – works completed. Surfacing at graveyard in 2022.</li> <li>• Ardmore – footpath to GAA field – communications ongoing with landowner.</li> <li>• Knockanore - footpath works underway including storm drain, removal of EIR cables, installation of public lighting and kerbing. Discussions underway with landowners regarding land required.</li> <li>• Lismore - kerbing and footpath proposal for Deerpark road within proximity of school on works programme and will commence soon.</li> <li>• Ballyduff – Section 38 being finalised in accordance with active travel’s requirements.</li> <li>• Senior Engineer of Active Travel Team will communicate on proposed works for 2022.</li> </ul>

12	<p><b><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Road lining ongoing throughout the District.</li> <li>• Davitt Quay –Tendering for repairs to cobble lock underway.</li> <li>• New equipment for Lismore playground completed.</li> <li>• 3 new public lighting installations at New Lane completed and switching on is imminent by ESB. Public lighting works at Kilgobnet GAA underway.</li> <li>• Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages.</li> <li>• Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying.</li> <li>• Hedgecutting is not permitted from March to September. Landowners should continue to check their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads that may cause road safety issue. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. Storm events are more frequent. Where safety hazards arise, works can be undertaken where risked assessed and deemed necessary.</li> <li>• Cycle signs being installed at locations throughout District informing drivers to give cyclist Space – 1.5m and 1.0m as required.</li> <li>• Pedestrian lights reported with issues were repaired.</li> <li>• Draft of sign being drawn up for Tallow – HGV to use relief road</li> <li>• Contractor to commence footpaths on Parnell Street week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> April 2022.</li> </ul>
