All metropolitan branches have been open for the first quarter of 2022 providing study spaces, lending facilities while hosting and organising both online and more in person events as the relaxing of restrictions has allowed. We are looking forward to meeting more people in branches across the county as our opening hours increase while keeping the best aspects of our online events and programmes.

There were 101 Library based & online activities and events in the metropolitan area during the first quarter of 2022 including events for the Well Festival of Art & Wellbeing, Engineers week, Seachtain na Gaeilge and Ireland Reads. On International Women's Day March 8<sup>th</sup> Waterford's 3rd Global Women's Conference 'Break the Bias' Event took place in the Theatre Royal. Ardkeen Library hosted My Gift to you, a personal history writing workshop with the support of historian Dr. Maxine Keoghan. This programme is funded by the Ireland fund.

Exhibitions were hosted across our libraries: 'EU in my region' a partnership with Europe Direct Waterford and the Southern Regional Assembly. 'The people we grow up to be' a series of portraits of the Intergenerational choir by photographer Davi Matheson. The CHERISH Project: Climate Change and Coastal Heritage exhibition and the Restoration Art Project.

Groups have been meeting in Library spaces including Book clubs, French conversation groups, Brothers of Charity movie screenings, Breastfeeding support groups, parent & toddler groups in addition to community meetings by Focus Ireland and other community organisations.

There are lots of events scheduled for the upcoming months, Climate Action week, Spring into Storytime, the Glassroom media literacy project, the Towers and Tales festival, Bealtaine and a pledged reading event with all secondary schools in Waterford, #WaterfordSchoolsRead.
