**Final Report on Draft Cois Trá Dungarvan Motorhomes, Motor and Camper Van
Parking Bye-Laws 2021**

Introduction

These bye-laws are being made to give a legal basis to use the recently developed camper van facility at “Quanns Field” as a car park for the purpose of restricting the classes of vehicles which may be admitted to it, to specify the charges to be made for the use of it, the periods for which vehicles may remain in it (including overnight parking) and to specify the conditions subject to which vehicles may use the car park.

Public Consultation

The draft bye-laws were advertised in the Dungarvan Leader and Waterford Today newspapers and on the Council’s website from 10th February, 2021 for public consultation, the submission deadline was 23rd March, 2021.

Submissions

2 submissions were received and considered and the recommendations are set out as follows:-

Bye-law No. 5 - The fee of €10 is enshrined in the bye-laws – consider managing the fee outside the bye-laws as an administrative process to allow for adjustment down in low season.	Agreed. Bye-law No. 5 has been amended to include the maximum charge as €10 and that this fee can be reduced during low season by Chief Executive Order, if required.
Submission - Críostóir Ó Faoláin, Green Party Rep.	Recommendation
Bye-law No. 6 Request that the pay & display ticket is provided in both official languages..	All Pay & Display tickets are bilingual.
Bye-law No. 7 - Request that a bilingual Fixed Penalty Notice be provided.	All Traffic Fines issued are bilingual.

Request that the bye-laws be made available in both official languages.	Agreed. Bye-laws will be available in both official languages.
