Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme Along the L3043 High Street, Kilmacthomas, Co. Waterford.

Proposal

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake road improvement works along High Street in Kilmacthomas along L3043 as set out on the attached drawing. The proposed works will consist of the following: additional uncontrolled pedestrian crossing, build outs, renewed road markings, widen footpaths, designated off road parking, gateway speed limit signs and renewed road signage.

The main goal is to reduce vehicular speed on approach to Kilmacthomas Village and have a safe route for walking and crossing. The implementation of the traffic calming scheme will create a safe environment for all road users with a strong emphasis on non-motorized road users.

Public Consultation

The proposal was advertised for public consultation in the Dungarvan Observer on 9th June, with submissions accepted up to 20th July, 2021. The proposal was also published on the website and sent to An Garda Siochána.
