Re: Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme Traffic Calming along the L4500, Upper Queen Street, Portlaw

The following proposed scheme was advertised for public consultation from **Tuesday 30th March to Monday 26th April, 2021.** submissions before 10th May, 2021

- Waterford City and County Council proposes to undertake the construction of a traffic calming scheme in the form of a controlled pedestrian crossing with raised table area to facilitate a safe crossing point along the L4500, Upper Queen Street, Portlaw and also control vehicular movements, see drawing attached.
- The main goal is to lead pedestrians to a designated controlled crossing point where
 crossing of Upper Queen Street is used regularly and in particular more frequently
 during school opening and closing hours. Construction of a raised table area will
 reduce speed of vehicular traffic. The implementation of the traffic calming scheme
 will create a safe environment for all road users with a strong emphasis on nonmotorized road users.
