ROADS PROGRESS REPORT SEPTEMBER 2020

A. Roads Works Programme 2020

Strengthening and surface dressing Works by the Machinery Yard are almost completed. Macadam Streets are completed. Drainage discretionary works will be included in RWP 2020 which will be provided across all 3 Areas of the District and these works will continue to take place under the Maintenance budgets.

B. Road Maintenance Works

The District area crews have been continuously filling potholes and repairing roads. Road repairs (potholes and damaged edges) and drainage discretionary works will continue to take place under the Maintenance budgets.

C. Footpath Works – Active Travel Measures

Department of Transport have allocated funding for repair/replace/install new footpaths through the Jobs Stimulus Funding package for Active Travel – details in separate report.

D. Climate Adaptation Measures

Department of Transport have allocated funding for Jobs Stimulus Funding package for Active Travel – details included in separate report.

E. Low Cost Schemes (Non-National Roads)

Local Improvement Schemes for 2020 for the Comeragh District Area. The following 2 Schemes have been completed:

- L-5073 to Junction with R671 Boolavoonteen Completed
- L4033 Brown Street, Portlaw Section 38 Traffic Calming Scheme approved Underway.

F. Bridge Rehabilitation Works on Regional and Local Roads

Bridge Rehabilitation works in 2020 update, namely:

• Knockalisheen €20,000

• Kill/Ballymurin €30,000 - Completed

Ballynamult €45,000 – To go out to tender

Knockaderry Lake €70,000 – Design completed for bridge rehabilitation and works gone out

to tender

G. Road Design Section

These works are being project managed by the Road Design Section

Lemybrien Pedestrian Crossing on N25

Consultant appointed to carry out detail design and preparation of Tender documents.

• Finger Post - Dungarvan - Clonmel Road

Construction works are progressing.

H. Clár

In August 2019, the department announced projects which secured funding under Measures 1 & 2 Clár Programme for Safety Measures and Play Areas improvements in the Comeragh Area.

Measures 1 Clár Programme the following works to be undertaken and update on progress:

 Rathgormack School/Community - To provide for lighting improvements, new lighting and footpath - € 49,950

Footpath completed. A lighting consultant appointed to undertake a lighting design. Consultant has furnished a report for procurement. ESB connection applied for and commencement preparation for procurement of lighting consultant. Lighting contractor installed new lights. ESB to connected supply.

Measures 2 Clár Programme the following works to be undertaken and update on progress:

Modeligo Community & School - € 49,950

School Play Area:

- Playground markings
- Boundary Fencing
- Improvements to MUGA (netting, boards)

Works have commenced.

Community Playground:

- Install wet pour surfacing to make the play area safer and more user friendly
- Improve access to the slide within the play area

Contractor has been appointed and works are almost completed.

In June 2020, the department announced applications for Measures 1 & 2 Clár Programme for Safety Measures and Community Recreational Areas and were submitted by Waterford Council in August 2020.
