Re: Final Report on Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme Improvement works along the R-673 College Road, and Tower Hill Road, Ardmore, Co. Waterford.

Details of Proposal

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake road improvement works along the R-673 College Road, and Tower Hill Road, Ardmore as set out on the drawing attached. Works will include the construction of a new 1.8m wide footpath which will extend from the existing footpath located on the southern side of College Road linking to Tower Hill Road and Main Street, Ardmore. A pedestrian crossing with Belisha Beacons will be installed at the junction of College Road and Tower Hill Road to provide safety for both pedestrians, cyclists and motorists. The goal of this scheme is to achieve pedestrian linkage from College Road onto Main street, Ardmore. The implementation of this scheme will create a safer environment for all road users.

Public Consultation

The proposal was advertised in the Dungarvan Leader and on the website from Wednesday 10th March to Tuesday 6th April, 2021. The final date for receipt of submissions was Tuesday 20th April, 2021. No submissions were received in respect of the proposal.
