**Re: Draft Waterford Metropolitan District Council Control of Parking Bye-Laws 2020 - proposed amendments**

The following proposed amendments have been reviewed and recommended by the Transportation & Infrastructure SPC at their meeting held on 27th February, 2020.

<b>Bye-Law</b>	<b>Current wording</b>	<b>Proposed change</b>	<b>Reason for change</b>
Part II - Pay Parking General 6.(1)(9)	"Tramore - the Promenade" as per Schedule 1 - the parking of Motorhome, Motor Caravans and Camper Vans are only permitted in designated parking spaces, within this pay and display zone during the pay and display periods. Designated spaces within this area are signed with the appropriate Motorhome, Motor Caravans and Camper Vans signage."	"Tramore - the Promenade" as per Schedule 1 - the parking of a Motorhome, Motor Caravan and Camper Van is permitted in parking spaces within the Promenade pay and display zone during the pay and display periods provided it does not project into an adjoining buffer area or adjoining parking bay area or extend into the road carriageway. Vehicles that do not meet this criteria must park in a designated space	To allow smaller style camper vans park in any space within the Promenade pay and display area where they fit into a standard parking bay.

New bye-law to be included "Part VIII - Parking Permit for Voluntary Organisations"	New bye-law.	Insert Part VIII to include bye-laws to cover the application, issue and particulars of the voluntary organisation parking permit.	Voluntary parking permits have existed for some time and this bye-law is required to regularise the application process in line with other permits and to provide a legal basis for the permit.
