WCCC is actively promoting and designing schemes to include permeability and connectivity measures to increase pedestrian and cycling activity in neighbourhoods. This issue is outside the scope of the taking in charge process for roads and services.
2.	Kill St. Lawrence	The Drive, Kill St. Lawrence Residents Association (98 signatures)	Objection to Planning Condition 18c 16/476 for pedestrian link between the Drive, KSL and The Court, Fairfield Park to be opened and demand for a new palisade security fencing to be erected.	As above.
