COMPLETION OF PROCESS

Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme Along the R675 Bunmahon, Co. Waterford

Proposal

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake road improvement works along R675 within Bunmahon Village as set out on the attached drawing. The proposed works will consist of the following: a controlled crossing point with raised table, build outs, narrowing road junction, renewed road markings and road signage.

The main goal is to provide a safe route for walking and crossing point to reduce vehicular speed which approaches Bunmahon Village. This scheme will link the footpaths along the main road to the Geopark and National School located to the North East along L3033. The implementation of the traffic calming scheme and active travel scheme will create a safe environment for all road users with a strong emphasis on non-motorized road users.

Public Consultation

The scheme was advertised for public consultation in the Dungarvan Leader and on our website from the 20th October inviting submissions up to 30th November, 2021. No submissions were received.

Recommendation

The scheme as advertised is recommended for your approval.
