**Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme
Along the R679/R677 Old Cork Road, Kilmacthomas, Co. Waterford.**

Proposal

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake road improvement works along R679/R677 Old Cork Road in Kilmacthomas as set out on the attached drawing. The proposed works will consist of the following: new footpaths, uncontrolled pedestrian crossing, a controlled crossing point with raised table, build outs, renewed road markings and renewed road signage.

The main goal is to provide a safe route for walking and crossing point to reduce vehicular speed which approaches Kilmacthomas Village. This scheme will link to Greenway access point to the East of village. The implementation of the traffic calming scheme and active travel scheme will create a safe environment for all road users with a strong emphasis on non-motorized road users.

Public Consultation

The proposal was advertised for public consultation in the Dungarvan Leader on 14th July, with submissions accepted up to 24th August, 2021. The proposal was also published on the website and sent to An Garda Síochána.
