Dear Ms Dunphy,

I refer to your recent representation on behalf of the Members of Waterford City and County Council in relation to St Otteran's Hospital site, Waterford.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

HSE Estates has been in discussion with Waterford City and County Council Planning Department and Housing Section over recent years during the development of a site Development Control Plan and changes to zoning of St Otteran's Hospital site, Waterford.

The vacant buildings and surrounding site areas are identified for future healthcare use. The HSE currently have a Design Team working on plans for development of Orthodontics and Audiology Services in part of the main St Otteran's buildings with a Planning Application lodged on 16th July 2021. This project is scheduled for delivery in 2022.

In addition we are further developing Feasibility/Preliminary Design plans for proposed Enhanced Community Care Hub on site. This would likely use up all vacant space within main buildings.

Lands zoned for housing purposes were previously offered to the Local Authority, however, it is understood that these were not required at the time. We are currently in initial discussion with the Land Development Agency on possible sale of lands zoned for housing.
