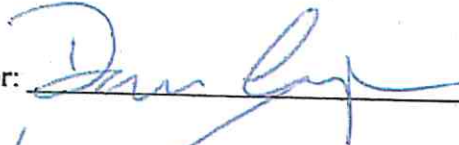

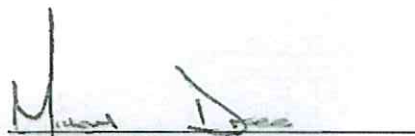
Dear Meeting Administrator,
