APPLICATION FOR A SECTION 57 DECLARATION

The above Act provides that any works that would affect the character of a protected structure or a proposed protected structure will require planning permission, even where those works would normally be exempt under the provisions of Section 4(1)(h) of the Act. As an owner/occupier of a protected structure you are entitled under the above Act to request the Council to issue a Declaration as to the type of works which may or may not materially affect the character of your structure.
