1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workshop for footpaths, Surface Dressing and Strengthening Programme 2024 arranged for 12th February pending grant funding. • Jet Patcher in District as per agreed Programme. • Storm Babet Macadam Surfacing repair works completed at Ballinnaha Hill, Ballyphilip, Castlemiles, Coolbeggan West, Boola, Ballinvilla, Glendine, Cherrymount, Ballyheany, Mill Road, Clashmore, Dromana Drive, Coolbagh Quay, Tinnascart, Ballyguiry, Kilnafarna, Ballylanagon, Currabaha, and Ballyconnery. Drainage and concrete culverts underway at some locations. Other Locations on works programme are Knockanearis, Kilcolman, Claddagh, Lacken, , Knockgarraun, Glenavaddra and Coolnasmear. Roads will continue to be assessed and prioritised by the District. Works will depend on funding for Storm Babet. Communications ongoing with the Department regarding cost and works required.

Pothole repairs ongoing.</p> <p>Lismore West - Drainage and Road repair works in Lismore Area, Ballyduff, Knockanore, Glendine, Kilwatermoy and Tallow area Environs including Storm Babet locations. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Pothole repairs ongoing. Knockanore active travel scheme near completion with final road lining underway.</p> <p>Lismore East - Drainage and Road repair works in Clashmore, Cappoquin Area, Villierstown, Dromore, Ballingowan, Aglish, and Clashmore including Storm Babet locations. 11.	<p><u>Bridges</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Schemes have been submitted for 2024. Awaiting communications on funding approval.
12.	<p><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Following low temperatures and heavy rainfall events there is an increase in potholes. Crews are dealing with potholes in the District. Continue to report on CRM and to District Engineer. Potholes will be filled as soon as possible.• Road lining ongoing throughout the District.• Davitt Quay –Further cobble lock repairs underway.• Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages.• Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying.• Hedgecutting is now permitted until end of February. Landowners should continue to check their boundary hedges and trees in front of public roads that may cause road safety issue. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. Section 70 Notices being issues to non-compliant landowners.
