



Overview

- The Waterford Economic Strategy 2040 has been developed by Waterford City & County Council as the organisation with the primary responsibility for the economic development of Waterford.
- The Strategy focuses on measures to maximise the capacity of Waterford Council to contribute to the economic development of Waterford and the wider region and the objectives identified in the strategy will be weighted towards local authority delivery and objectives that the local authority can deliver in partnership with other economic stakeholders.
- This Strategy provides a link between Waterford Council's strategic vision contained in the Corporate Plan, our Development Plan, our Capital Programme and our annual budget.





- Sustain/expand existing enterprises, particularly in sectors having significant growth potential in international markets
- Empower, retain and attract people with the skills for the future and ESG talent
- Enhance opportunities for clustering and collaboration for sectors that are active on the world stage
- Develop social enterprises in the circular economy to benefit environmental protection and employment generation
- Scaling of established indigenous enterprises to maximise their growth and job creation potential

- Establish Waterford as a place of choice for talent and investment and market Waterford as such (W2040)
- Build Waterford City's critical mass to fulfil its' role as a driver for economic development for the South East
- Create urban centres which offer a diverse choice of attractive, high quality places, centred on the human scale and accessible to all.
- Strengthen the economic fabric of smaller towns/villages and their capacity to advance rural economic regeneration
- Develop Waterford as a sustainable and accessible place that is attractive to both domestic and international visitors with a sense of place and connected tourist amenities to enhance and support local communities and realise additional economic growth for Waterford
- Drive the delivery of housing of all types in key areas in Waterford
- Protect, manage and enhance the natural heritage, biodiversity, landscape and environment of Waterford in recognition of its importance as a non-renewable resource, providing a unique identity and character for Waterford



Technology & Digital Transformation



- Develop Waterford as a SMART City to make Waterford more efficient and liveable to boost Waterford's location profile as an innovative place.
- Drive the revitalisation of rural communities through social and digital innovation and community and support their transition from traditional villages to SMART Villages status.
- Drive the further digitalisation of public services to ensure maximum digital optimisation and transformation for citizens, businesses, and government. (Waterford's Digital Strategy).
- Drive a step-change in the digital transformation of businesses, in particular SMEs; sustain Ireland's attractiveness as a location for leading digital enterprises; and maximise the benefits of the digital transition for the wider economic ecosystem.
- Support the development of a county wide innovation ecosystem and network of Enterprise Centres aligned to research centres of excellence in SETU.
