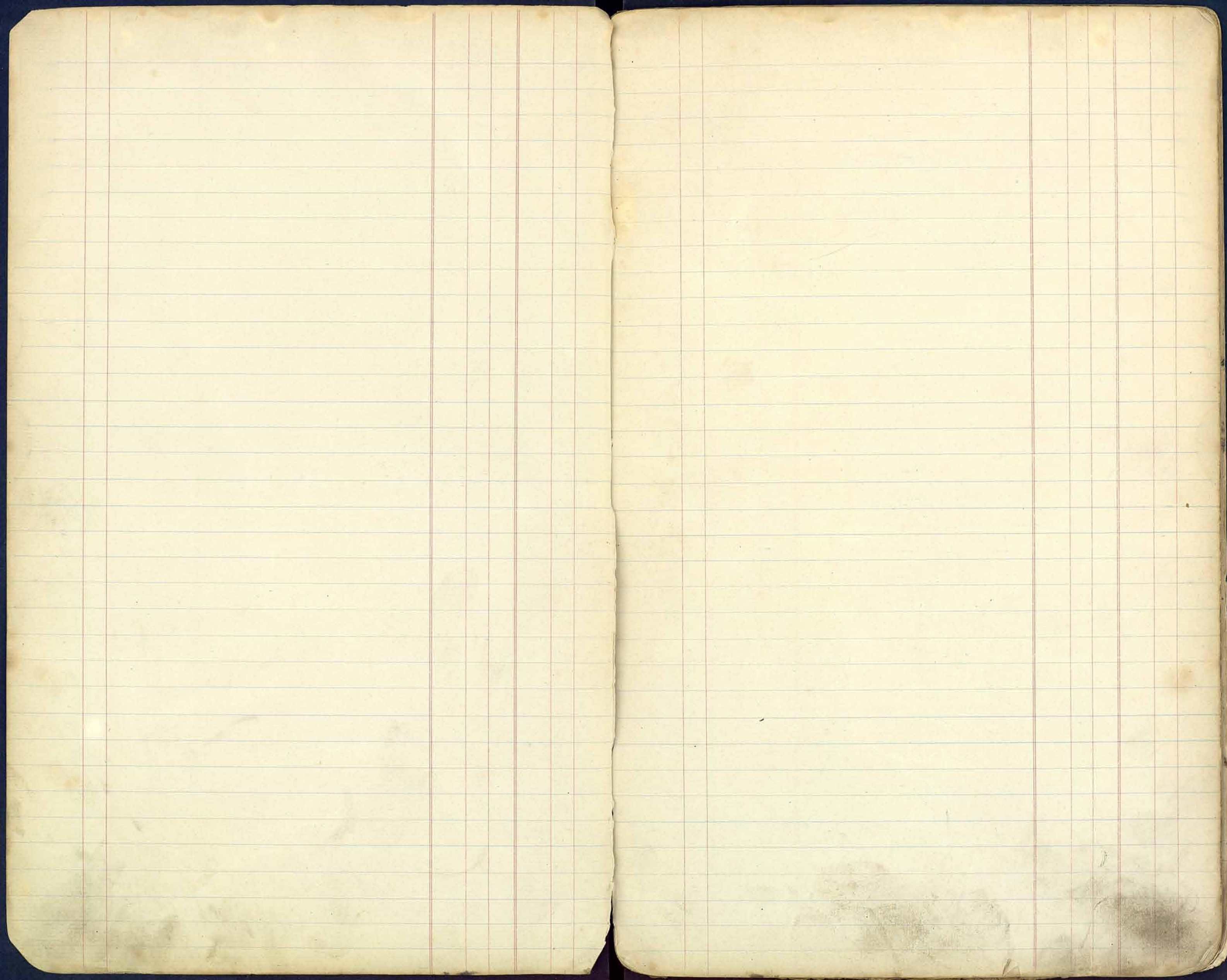

Valerian Root:— Used in the same manner as Mistletoe and for similar Complaints can be purchased in powdered form. In this form dose:— a teaspoonful in a Cup of hot water

Appendicitis or Inflammation of the Wormiform Appendix

This complaint always makes its presence known by dull aching pains at the lower right abdominal region just above the groin. These pains become more frequent and intense as the disease advances until when the complaint approaches the acute stage the pain is agonising and continues. On the first appearance of these pains the patient if an adult should take a desert spoonfull of Olive oil. Two hours afterwards another desert spoonful of the oil should be taken.

Half an hour after the first dose of the Olive oil has been taken a wine glassfull of an Infusion of Elder flowers and Peppermint should be taken.

This infusion is made by pouring a pint of hot water over an oz. of Elder flowers and an oz. of Peppermint. This should be let stand for a quarter of an hour & be taken hot at the same time. Hot fomentations should be applied to the affected part. Attacked in the early stages in this manner the complaint should have disappeared in 12 hours. Vomiting nearly always accompanies an attack of Appendicitis
