3.	Proposed changes to 360/360A	• Proposed revised 360 and 360A route between Waterford and Tramore was discussed. Cllr Joe Kelly updated the committee from a recent NTA meeting he attended stating that some of the proposed changes in Tramore are now being reviewed by the NTA. J. Farnan said that clarity was also needed on the Kilbarry route and the proposed elimination of the SETU and Whitfield stops. Cllr J. Griffin raised the issue of the provision of bus shelters. G. Hynes SE said that the NTA have funding but want local authorities to provide them, including the design and construction however the Council do not have the required resources to do this. F. 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4. PPN Issues	<ul> <li>1 &amp; 2 - J. Farnan asked for an update on the bus park and ride and orbital routes. F. Galvin DOS said that no park and ride sites have been identified and the orbital routes are a couple of years away but he will follow up with NTA on expected dates.</li> <li>3 &amp; 4 - traffic safety and lining issues were raised in relation to the following junctions at Kingsmeadow, Barrack Street, Newgate Street and at the Railway Station and discussed. G. Hynes SE said that some valid points had been made and that these junctions would be reviewed by the District Engineer. Junction at the Cork Road will be part of the redesign by Active Travel. A discussion followed on the upcoming proposals from Active Travel in relation to cycle lanes and the challenges that the new road/lane designs will bring for all. It was agreed by all that these changes will have a significant impact on motorists and it will take time to create that modal shift to cycling and public transport.</li> </ul>	F. Galvin DOS
