- Ní mór saoránacht Éireannach a bheith agat, nó bheith i do náisiúnach de Bhallstát den Aontas Eorpach (seachas Éire) ar nó roimh an Aoine, 07 Meitheamh 2024.

Vóta Poist

Cé is féidir iarratas a dhéanamh ar vóta poist?

- Bheith i do chónaí sa bhaile agus gan a bheith in ann freastal ar stáisiún vótála chun vóta a chaitheamh de bharr breoiteachta nó míchumais.
- Ní féidir leat vóta a chaitheamh ag do stáisiún vótála, mar gheall ar chúinsí gairme nó oideachais.
- Comhalta lánaimseartha d'Óglaigh na hÉireann. Is féidir baill a bhfuil cónaí orthu i mbeairic mhíleata a chlárú ag an mbeairic nó ag a seoladh baile.
- Taidhleoir Éireannach atá postaithe thar lear, agus do chéile, agus atá cláraithe ag do sheoladh baile in Éirinn.
- Ball den Garda Síochána. Tá an rogha agat a bheith cláraithe mar ghnáththoghthóirí nó mar phostvótálaithe. Má thugtar vóta poist duit, ní féidir leat vótáil ach tríd an bpost.
- Ní féidir leat vóta a chaitheamh ag do stáisiún vótála mar gheall ar chúinsí do choinneála i bpríosún de bhun ordú cúirte.
- Dá gcuirfí do shábháilteacht nó sábháilteacht do theaghlach i mbaol dá bhfoirseofaí d'ainm agus do sheoladh, is féidir leat iarratas a dhéanamh le bheith i do thoghthóir gan ainm. Má dhéantar tú a thairfeadh mar "thoghthóir anaithnid", ní bheidh d'ainm ná do sheoladh ar fáil lena n-íniúchadh. Is trí theistiméireacht amháin a chuirfear san áireamh thú agus is tríd an bpost a vótálfaidh tú agus ní fhreastalóidh tú ar do stáisiún vótála ar lá na vótála.

Liosta Vótálaithe Speisialta:

Déan iarratas má tá cónaí ort i dteach altranaís nó in institiúid den chineál céanna agus mura féidir leat freastal ar stáisiún vótála mar gheall ar bhreoiteacht nó míchumais.

Má bhí vóta poist breoiteachta/míchumais agat sa Reifreann deireanach i 2024, ní gá iarratas a dhéanamh in athuair.

REGISTER OF ELECTORS

It is now your responsibility to ensure that you are registered to vote.

New Registration

The Local and European Elections will be held on 7 June 2024. If you are eligible to vote and not on the register of electors you must apply on or before **Monday 20 May 2024**.

To be eligible to vote in the Local Elections:

- You must be 18 years of age on or before Friday, 07 June 2024.
- You must be living full time at the address at which you wish to be registered.

To be eligible to vote in the European Elections:

- You must be 18 years of age on or before Friday, 07 June 2024.
- You must be living full time at the address at which you wish to be registered.
- You must have Irish citizenship or a national of a Member State of the European Union (other than Ireland) on or before Friday 07 June 2024.

How to apply:

- On-line on www.checktheregister.ie.
- Hard copy forms (ERF1) are available at Waterford City and County Council, City Hall, The Mall, Waterford; Customer Services desks, Baileys New Street, Waterford, and Civic Offices, Dungarvan, Co. Waterford, as well as from our public libraries. Copies also available to download at www.checktheregister.ie.

Postal Vote

Who can apply for a postal vote?

- Living at home and cannot attend a polling station to vote due to an illness or disability.
- Unable to vote at your polling station, due to circumstances of occupation or education.
- Whole-time member of the Defences Forces. Members who live in military barracks may be registered either at the barracks or at their home address.
- An Irish diplomat posted abroad, and your spouse, and are registered at your home address in Ireland.
- A member of the Garda Síochána. You have the option of being registered as ordinary electors or as postal voters. If you are granted a postal vote you may only vote by post.
- Unable to vote at your polling station due to circumstances of your detention in a prison pursuant to an order of a court.
- If publishing your name and address would jeopardise your safety or that of your household, you can apply to be an anonymous elector. If you are recorded as an "anonymous elector" your name and address will not be available for inspection. You will be included by a reference only and you will vote by post and not attend your polling station on polling day.

Special Voters List:

Apply if you live in a nursing home or similar institution and cannot attend a polling station due to illness or disability.

If you have had an illness/disability postal vote in the last Referendum in 2024, there is no need to re-apply.

How to Apply?

Contact Waterford City and County Council on 0818 10 2020 or email franchise@waterfordcouncil.ie to check your postal voter status or to enquire about your eligibility. Forms to apply for a postal vote can be downloaded at www.checktheregister.ie.

Applications for entry onto the postal voters list must be received on or before the closing date **Saturday, 11 May 2024**.
