1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jet Patcher in District as per agreed Programme. • Works underway in Strengthening, Surface Dressing and severe weather programme as approved at March meeting. • Flash flooding in May caused damage to roads in Ballynaclash, Crinnaghtaun, Crowhill, Tooranaraheen and Knocknafallia. Further funding will be requested from the Department of Transport. • Contractor will commence road surfacing in District commencing in Tallow and on to Dungarvan Town.
2.	<p><u>OPW Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Erosion Risk Management Study in Ardmore – waiting on communications from OPW. • Detention Pond, Duckspool - topsoil will be completed throughout the site by contractor during August weather permitting. • Tender for Seawall at Clonea – communications regarding data from OPW required.
3.	<p><u>Footpath Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full re-construction completed on sections at Mitchel street, Dungarvan, Chapel street/Main street Tallow. • Footpath reconstruction underway at Banksfield and Deerpark Lismore • Footpath outside post office in Cappoquin to be raised to facilitate all users. • Footpath repairs completed in An Rath, Piltown (Dungarvan South), Ashcroft Estate, Kings Street (Dungarvan North), Shanbally (Lismore East).
4.	<p><u>TII Funding/National Roads</u></p> <p>The following funding was approved by TII for maintenance on N72 and N25 in District.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • N25 D/L Dungarvan to Rhincrew county bounds opening inlets, side cleaning - €17,500 • N72 D/L Drainage Dungarvan to Tallow, side cleaning and opening inlets - €18,500 • N72 D/L Hedge, grass and tree cutting on network Dungarvan to Tallow - €31,500 • N25 D/L Hedge, grass and tree cutting on network Dungarvan to county Bounds - €28,500 • N25 D/L Storm water network Kilrush to Youghal roundabout, Dungarvan - €15,800 • N72 D/L Defective sections on network Cappoquin, Little bridge - €30,000 • N25 D/L Defective sections on network Piltown/Ticknock, Newtown, Grange - €50,000

6.	<p><u>Low-Cost Schemes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clonea Lower crossing regional road R675 - €30,000 – works completed. • Lyre Woods, Glenribeen, Glenknockaun safety barrier - €50,000 – procurement underway. • Carriglea, Bog road traffic calming - €95,000 – works underway.
7.	<p><u>Section 38's</u></p> <p>Section 38's will be undertaken where Traffic calming works are proposed throughout the District.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carriglea (Bog Road) was advertised for Traffic Calming Scheme and scheme underway. • Section 38 Western Terrace was advertised. The proposal is to construct a new section of footpath. The scheme will be discussed at future workshop.
8.	<p><u>Climate Adaption Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ballysaggart Drainage works - €20,000. – Lismore West - on works programme. • Snugborough Drainage works - €15,000 – Lismore West - on works programme. • Ballyneety Drainage works - €50,000 – Dungarvan North - on works programme. • Ballycureen South Drainage works - €10,000 – Dungarvan South - on works programme.
9.	<p><u>Active Travel</u></p> <p>Schemes have been submitted for 2024. Schemes presented by Active Travel team at workshop. Ballinroad scheme is on the Active Travel Department's work programme.</p>
10.	<p><u>Other works</u></p> <p>Dungarvan North - Road repairs ongoing at Ballymarket, Ballylemon, Kilgobnet, Lacken, Coolnasmear and Environs. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Pothole repairs ongoing. Side cleaning underway for works programme. Strengthening and Surface Dressing programme underway.</p> <p>Pedestrian Crossing works extending from Greenway to Clonea Castle strand road along R675 is completed.</p> <p>Greenway Link from Ballinard carpark to Ballinclamper is completed. Pedestrian crossing works/raised crossing/lining works/erection of Belisha at Ballinclamper crossing is completed. 	<p>Lismore East - Drainage and Road repair works in Clashmore, Cappoquin Area, Villierstown, Dromana, Melleray, Aglish and Clashmore including Storm Babet locations. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Pothole repairs ongoing. Side cleaning near completion for Strengthening and Surface Dressing programme.</p> <p>Dungarvan South - Drainage and road repair works underway in An Rinn, Helvick, Old Parish, Grange, Ballybrusa, and Ardmore area including Storm Babet locations. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Pothole repairs ongoing. Side cleaning near completion for Strengthening and surface dressing programme.</p>
11.	<p><u>Bridges</u></p> <p>Engineering Support Team tendering these works:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monalour Bridge , North of Cappoquin - €115,000 • Lyre Bridge , near Cappoquin - €35,000 • Shandon Island Bridge near Dungarvan - €20,000 • Bridge at Melleray Grotto, Melleray - €35,000 • Gloungarriff Bridge, between Cappoquin and Vee - €35,000 • Kilbeg Upper Bridge between Tallow and Youghal - €27,000 • Bridge at Knockanporragh, near Knockanore - €20,000
12.	<p><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repair of Potholes on going. • Road lining ongoing throughout the District. • Davitts Quay – further cobble lock repairs underway. • Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages. • Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying. • Hedgecutting is not permitted until September as per Wildlife Act. Landowners should continue to check their boundary hedges and trees in front of public roads that may cause road safety issue. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. Landowner’s co-operation to date is appreciated.
