Civil Defence activities during the month of March 2025 continues with assistance in the response to the urgent needs of the Displaced Persons (DP's) fleeing from the effects of the Ukraine Crisis.

National Radiation Monitoring Exercise. On Saturday the 1st March, Civil Defence units nationally, were activated as part of a national radiation exercise to take samples of both grass and soil for analysis by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This is an annual event that enables the EPA to monitor levels in the soil country wide.

Waterford Civil Defence was chosen as the lead unit for the coordination and collection of Background Radiation Readings from across the South East. This was in the form of both Grass and Soil samples for onward delivery to the SETU Dept of Science Main Campus Waterford. We were delighted to be working in collaboration with the SETU Dept of Science, who work closely with the Environmental Protection Agency for whom Civil Defence survey teams collected samples.
