1.	<p><u>Road Works Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2025 Road Works Programme: Surface dressing completed Strengthening on going.
	<p><u>Low Cost Safety Schemes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2025 allocations received, as follows: L5507-7 Knockhouse €30,000...95% complete. L4066-0 Kilcarragh Cross €15,000...90% complete R675 – 88 Coolnacapogue Tramore €35,000 R680 Orchardstown Cross €30,000 L4209-10: Killea, Dunmore East €45,000, Contractor due to commence.
3	<p><u>Climate Adaptation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2025 allocations received, as follows: L4082 – Jack Meades Drainage €10,000 – completed R685-7 Lisselan Road Drainage €10,000 R685-6 Tramore Road €40,000 R675-122 Tramore Ring Road €20,000. These works postponed until after Active Travel works. Funding will be used for Cove Road. R675-187 Waterford Road drainage €45,000 - completed L8078 Cove Road Tramore €25,00 - tender completed, contractor due to be appointed.

	<p>Proposed Part VIII Schemes (Planning & Development Act, 2000 as amended Planning & Development Regulations 2001 as amended Part VIII)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Proposed Pedestrian Lighting – The People’s Park Kilcaragh Park – Development of a play and recreational area

	<p>Both these proposed developments were initially brought to the Metropolitan Meeting on 21st October 2024. As the members are aware, resource issues prevented the progression of both projects. It is now proposed to formally commence the Part 8 Process, advertise both developments, and bring the Chief Executive's Report for decision at the September Metropolitan Meeting.</p>
	<p><u>Active Travel</u></p> <p><u>Inner Ring Road Active Travel Scheme</u></p> <p>Section 38 process commenced at the April Metropolitan MD meeting on Tuesday 22nd April 2025. 58 submissions were received during the public consultation period (23rd April 2025 to 21st May 2025), with 3 received outside of this time giving a total of 61 submissions. Subject to approval of the revised WCCC Section 38 procedures currently under discussion, the Section 38 report for the scheme will be circulated to the Elected Members at the September Metropolitan District meeting. An in-person meeting between the Elected Members, Active Travel staff and the scheme designers (Atkins Ltd.), is planned for early September.</p> <p><u>Saint John of God NS SRTS</u></p> <p>Section 38 process commenced at the April Metropolitan MD meeting on Tuesday 22nd April 2025.</p> <p>113 submissions were received during the public consultation period (23rd April 2025 to 7th May 2025).</p> <p>Following receipt of the public submissions and further discussions between WCCC and Saint John of God school on the original plans, revised plans have now been developed in collaboration with the school (based on changing a portion of Passage Road from two way to a one way street (in an east west direction)). Subject to approval of the revised WCCC Section 38 procedures currently under discussion, the Section 38 report for the scheme will be circulated to the Elected Members at the September Metropolitan District meeting.</p> <p><u>Williamstown Road Active Travel Scheme</u></p> <p>Section 38 process commenced at the March Metropolitan MD meeting held on Tuesday 18th March 2025.</p> <p>28 submissions were received during the public consultation period held from 19th March to 16th April 2025.</p> <p>Subject to approval of the revised WCCC Section 38 procedures currently under discussion, the Section 38 report for the scheme will be circulated to the Elected Members at the September Metropolitan District meeting.</p> <p><u>Scoil Mhuire Butlerstown NS SRTS</u></p> <p>Section 38 process commenced at the March Metropolitan MD meeting held on Tuesday 18th March 2025. 2 submissions were received during the public consultation period held from 19th March to 2nd April 2025.</p> <p>Construction of the scheme commenced on July 3rd last (works are scheduled for the summer school closure period). Main contractor for the scheme is Tom Delahunty Plant Hire Ltd. Subject to approval of the revised WCCC Section 38 procedures currently under discussion, the Section 38 report for the scheme will be circulated to the Elected Members at the September Metropolitan District meeting.</p>
