<p>8.</p>	<p><b><u>July Stimulus Package</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel Coolagh Road Crossing Point – Civil works including ducting, drainage and installation of sockets near completion.</li> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel Cross Bridge St Dungarvan – Commenced works 23<sup>rd</sup> November. The existing footpath removed in sections and ducting, drainage and paving will be completed as sections are removed.</li> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel O Connell St Dungarvan – Footpath works completed. Any snag items being addressed.</li> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel Davitts Quay/Walsh St - Ducting works completed. Civil works near completion for undergrounding ESB overhead cables. ESB programmed to be on site January 2021 to underground overhead cables.</li> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel Ballyheeney Rd Clashmore – Drainage and ducting works near completion. Kerbing construction completed. Two additional public lights on existing ESB poles to be installed. Concrete footpath near completion.</li> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel Duffcarrick Ardmore Footpath – Footpath, drainage works and public lighting completed.</li> <li>• DTTAS Active Travel An Rinn Footpath and Crossing – Ducting, drainage, kerbing, concrete footpath and public lighting completed. 10. Item Raised/Other Works

- Road lining ongoing throughout the District.
- Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages.
- Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying.
- Hedgecutting is now permitted September until February. Landowners should continue to cut their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints.
- Following recent weather landowners should check trees and hedges on their landholding in particular trees/hedges in line with public roads.
- Cycle signs being installed at locations throughout District informing drivers to give cyclist Space – 1.5m and 1.0m as required.
- Camper van parking near completion. Connection of services imminent. Pay machine to be installed following Bye-Laws.
- Cappoquin Pedestrian crossing – Funding received €27,500 - Civil works, drainage and kerbing completed. Sockets for installation of belisha beacon are underway.
- Lismore - funding received - 6k for extension to millennium park – Works completed to set back fencing.
- Ardmore – funding received - €45,000 for raised table and widen footpath to accommodate social distancing – Raised Table and widening of footpath completed.
- Clashmore – funding received -€25,000 for planting, seating, fencing and stone wall. Works underway by Tidy Towns.
- Installation of culvert at Kilnafrahan Bridge completed.
- R666 Lismore towards Ballyduff road closure proposed to commence on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2021 to facilitate embankment repairs by landowner.
