Re: Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme  
along the L-2005, Knockanore, Co. Waterford

The following proposed scheme was advertised for public consultation from 25th March, 2020 to 21st April, 2020 inviting submissions before 5th May, 2020.

- Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake the construction of a traffic calming scheme along the L-2005 through Knockanore. This will be achieved by constructing kerbed islands located at 4 No. specified locations on the approaches and through Knockanore.
- Centreline road and edge line road markings shall be provided through the extent of works on the approaches and through Knockanore.
- Existing 'SLOW' road markings and School line marking shall be refreshed.
- Additional 'SLOW' road markings through village shall be provided.
- Additional Public Lighting shall be provided on approach to Knockanore.
- The implementation of the proposed works should achieve speed reduction through Knockanore and in particular on the approach to the National School and local Parish Church. The implementation of this traffic calming scheme will create a safer environment for all road users.

One submission was received from Fr. Condon Parish Priest who requested consultation on the location of Build-out No. 3 as the location could create difficulty to vehicles during large gatherings.

Gabriel Hynes, Senior Engineer, and Josephine McGrath, Senior Executive Engineer, met representatives of the School/Community Hall Committee/ Parish Priest on site and the proposal was agreed by all parties subject to one minor revision to build-out No. 2. It was agreed to relocate build-out No. 2 near the Health Centre, 20m towards Knockanore Cross. It was agreed that all other build-outs were to remain the same as agreed on site.

Your approval to proceed with the scheme as set out on the revised attached drawing is requested.
