1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strengthening and Surface Dressing Programme undertaken by Machinery Yard near completion. Remaining strengthening and surface dressing will be completed in the coming weeks. • Jet Patcher’s work is ongoing in the District. • Non National macadam tender awarded and works completed in Ardmore and Dungarvan Town. Raised table in Ardmore to be completed.
2.	<p><u>OPW Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application for funding sent to OPW for retaining wall/rock armour along Ardmore beach line and investigation to seawall at Gold Coast.
3.	<p><u>Coastal Repair Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2020 applications submitted to Department for Helvick Pier Repairs and access ladders at Ticknock Pier/Youghal Bridge. Helvick Pier tender and Tender for ladders awarded to contractors. Works underway at both locations.
4.	<p><u>TII Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funding application to be sent to TII for additional funding to deal with Storm Ellen and Storm Francis. • N25 tree removal and treecare funding received from TII. Presentation dealing with this contract. Works programmed being planned.
5.	<p><u>CIS and LIS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CIS being finalised. • LIS 2020 Ballyheeneey, Clashmore – Preparation works underway for machinery yard to surface and concrete channel will be completed following surfacing. • LIS 2020 Rhincrew – drainage works completed and surfacing to follow by machinery yard.
6.	<p><u>CLAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Department of Rural and Community Development requested submissions for CLAR 2020. Application sent to Department.
7.	<p><u>Low Cost Schemes</u></p> <p>Funding received for the following schemes;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aglish - €25,000 – sightline improvement R671/L2021 – Works underway to set back boundary wall. • Ballyvoile - €40,000 – Signage and lining installation underway. • Crotty Corner -€70,000 – Works underway to install belisha beacon and raised table. Traffic management in place.

<p>8.</p>	<p><u>Other works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dungarvan North – strengthening and surface dressing near completion. Road repairs ongoing. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Drainage completed at Ballinroad (L7013). Due to depth of dig in Ballinroad settlement will require a number of months and surfacing will follow when appropriate. Clean up following Storm Ellen and Strom Francis underway. • Lismore West – strengthening and surface dressing near completion. Road repair works at Lismore area, Ballyduff area and Tallow area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Funding for Lady Lousia walk included installation of footpath to connect walkway. Footpaths repairs completed in Tallow. Clean up following Storm Ellen and Strom Francis underway. • Lismore East – Strengthening and surface dressing near completion. Drainage and road repair works in Cappoquin Area, Aglish, and Melleray area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Drainage completed at Villierstown. Stone masonry walls programmed for Tourin and Ballyheeny. Clean up following Storm Ellen and Strom Francis underway. • Dungarvan South - strengthening and surface dressing near completion. Drainage and road repair works underway in Old Parish, and Ardmore area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. First section of drainage completed on High Road, Ardmore and remaining section to follow. Concrete footpath construction in Ardmore. Clean up following Storm Ellen and Storm Francis underway.
<p>9.</p>	<p><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Road lining ongoing throughout the District. • Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages. • Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying. • Hedgecutting is now permitted September until February. Landowners should continue to cut their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. • Following recent weather events Storm Ellen and Storm Francis, several trees fell at various locations throughout the District. Landowners should check trees on their landholding in particular trees in line with public roads. Location where trees fell and drainage issues during storms being finalised. • Camper van parking - works progressing. Excavation of topsoil and subsoil completed. Capping layer and stone layer constructed. Kerb line progressing and connection to existing services underway including ducting for public lighting and pipes for drainage.
