**Re: Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme**  
**Along the L-3012 Cloncoskoran on approach to Garranbane National School**

**Proposal**

The following proposed scheme was advertised for public consultation from 10<sup>th</sup> February to 9<sup>th</sup> March 2021, inviting submissions before 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2021.

- Road improvement works along the L-3012 Cloncoskoran on the approach to Garranbane National School.
- This will be achieved by constructing a 2.0 m and 1.8 m wide footpath extending from the junction of L-3012 and L-3013 towards the entrance to Garranbane National School.
- Works also include public lighting, construction of a pedestrian crossing with Belisha Beacons, improved road markings and flashing lights approaching school as set out on the attached drawing.
- The main goal is to achieve a safe environment for the drop off and collection of school children working in conjunction with the newly constructed drive in and drive out car park system currently in operation. The implementation of this scheme will create a safer environment for all road users.

Request that if possible as part of this project appropriate signage be placed on both sides of the N25 on approach to Cuscam junction to warn HGV drivers that the junction is inaccessible to them and that roads L-3012 and L-3013 are unsuitable for heavy vehicles.	This element of the submission is outside of the scope of the scheme advertised. We will inform TII of the submissions as the signage would be required on the N25 National route. This is currently being addressed in the scheme proposed for N25 Cuscam.

Your approval to proceed with the proposed scheme as advertised is recommended for approval.
