1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strengthening works near completion on Local and Regional roads throughout the District. Surface Dressing underway in Lismore East, Lismore West and Dungarvan North and Dungarvan South to follow. Jacknell Street, lookout surfacing (removal of cobble and macadam surfacing near arch), Crossbridge Street and Strandside completed. Jet Patcher in District as per Machinery Yard's programme.
2.	<p><u>OPW Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Details for Erosion Risk Management Study in Ardmore sent to OPW and waiting communications from OPW.
3.	<p><u>Coastal Repair Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Procurement underway for Ballinacourty Pier €70,000. Recommencement of construction works at Helvick Pier are imminent - €200,000.
4.	<p><u>TII Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Funding applications approved for pavement overlay schemes at N25 Ticknock - €200,000 and N25 Ballybrusa/Ferrypoint - €200,000. – Procurement underway. Funding applications approved to deal with defective road surface - €50,000 and footpaths - €50,000 in Cappoquin. Procurement finalised and works are imminent.
5.	<p><u>CIS and LIS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CIS schemes and LIS schemes 2021 underway.
6.	<p><u>CLAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Knockanore Traffic Calming - €49,500–Section 38 approved and works will commence within two weeks.
7.	<p><u>Low Cost Schemes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dromana €60,000 - height restriction measures to prevent arch being struck at bridge – signage being finalised. Tallow at Grotto €30,000. Design to realign the junction being finalised.

9.	<p><u>Active Travel</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Villierstown – Footpath completed on road near Villierstown School. Section 38 providing connectivity from existing footpath at junction (road from Woodview Estate) to existing footpath in Main Street • AGLISH - kerbing/footpath/public lighting proposal in front of houses where drainage completed. Works to commence within two weeks. • Davitt Quay/Devonshire Bridge – Works completed. • Walsh Street - pedestrian crossing with Belisha beacon completed. • Garranbane –Drainage, ducting and boundary wall completed. Remaining kerbing, public lighting underway. • Strandside south /Minnies – Construction underway for widening footpath and connectivity as per Section 38. Strandside surfacing completed. • Ballinroad village –Drainage and kerbing completed. Footpath underway on road to graveyard. Surfacing will follow. • Crossbridge Street –Section of footpath paved (opposite Lady Belle) completed. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dungarvan South - Drainage and road repair works underway in Ferrypoint, Glenbeg, Old Parish, Ballybrusa, An Rinn, Grange and Ardmore area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing.
11.	<p><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Road lining ongoing throughout the District. • Outdoor Dining – Section 254 Licence required from Planning Department. • Installation of Bike stands for car parks and any appropriate location being reviews and works on work programme. • Bollards installed around bike stand in Ardmore. • Review of signage regarding HGV on Chapel Street, Tallow • Works to increase length of driver testing Bay on Walsh Street. Works to commence within two weeks. • Litter and dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages. • Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying. • Hedgecutting is not permitted from March 1st to 31st August. Landowners should continue to check their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads that may cause road safety issue. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. Roads only cutting where necessary for visibility at junctions. • Footpath approval for Mitchell/Parnell Street, Dungarvan, Shanbally, Cappoquin, Clashmore and West Street Talllow. Works on work programme. • Scanlon Yard car park /Car park across from civic offices– Full resurfacing of car parks completed. • Surfacing completed at staff/part-time public car park and public car park at Greenway. • Cycle signs being installed at locations throughout District informing drivers to give cyclist Space – 1.5m and 1.0m as required. • N72 road resurfacing works from Ballylemon to Cappagh underway.
