**Re: Section 38 Road Traffic Act 1994 - Traffic Calming Scheme  
Improvement works along the L-2005 Knockanore & L-6020 GAA/Community  
Field approach road.**

### **Proposal**

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake road improvement and traffic calming works along the L-2005 Knockanore & L-6020 GAA/Community Field approach road. Traffic calming measures will include the construction of a series of kerbed build out islands extending from the 50kph speed limit entry signage and through the village of Knockanore along with improved road markings, road signage and public lighting. A pedestrian crossing with flashing beacons will be installed adjacent to the National School to provide safe movement for pedestrians to a newly constructed 2.0m wide footpath with public lighting extending from the Recycling Centre entrance to the School grounds and continuing on to the pedestrian access to the GAA/ Community Field along the L-6020. The objective of this scheme is to achieve speed reduction through Knockanore and on the approach to the National school and the local Church in addition to the new pedestrian linkages.

### **Public Consultation**

The proposal was advertised for public consultation in the Dungarvan Leader and on the website from the 28<sup>th</sup> April to 25<sup>th</sup> May with a closing date of 8<sup>th</sup> June for submissions.

### **Submissions**

No submissions were received.
