Roads Progress Report to end of April 2021

1. Road Works Programme

The Road Works Programme 2021 Macadam tender was advertised on the 12th March 2021. On the closing date the 9th of April 2021 a total of three tenders were received. The preferred tender was submitted by Roadstone Limited. This Contract will be awarded in May and a schedule for the list of works will be agreed with works likely to start in June. The Machinery Yard surface dressing works will commence in mid-June and preparations are currently underway across the Metro District. Drainage works will also commence in the coming weeks.

2. Community Involvement schemes

We are waiting approval for funding for the CIS scheme for 2021.

3. Low Cost Safety Schemes

The following is a list of schemes for which funding approval has been submitted for 2021 in the Metropolitan District:

- i. Ballinattin on the R685 improvement works to junction – land to be acquired.
- ii. Footpath and pedestrian crossing completion at Quarry Road – to be confirmed as funding from Active Travel may be made available for completion of this work.
- iii. Killea Road Dunmore East completion of footpath works.

4. Coastal Repair works

A detailed application for funding was made for 2021 to the Department of Agriculture Food and Marine to approve further funding for coastal repair works at Tramore Pier and in addition funding for works to carry out repairs at Cheekpoint Pier. Confirmation of this funding is due in May.

5. Road Closures

No additional road closures in April.

6. Other Works

Tramore Area

- Pothole repairs in the Highfield Estate, Summerhill, Ballycashin, Cliff Road, The Prom Car Park and in the River Park Estate.
- The Council Jet Patcher was working on the L-8038 Kilbride Road.
- Side cleaning on a number of roads in preparation for surface dressing and strengthening works in the Metro West Area.
- Drainage works on the Garrus Road (collapsed culvert) and on the Kilbride Road.
- Footpath repairs on the Prom in Tramore, in Kennedy Park, Ballycarnane Woods Estate and at The Cove Tramore.

- Illegal dumping cleared from the Carrigavantry and the Ring Road Tramore. Also bags collected from Kilbride Road and Newtown following community litter picks.
- Replacing damaged and missing bollards on the Prom.
- New Stop sign and island at Springmount Estate, cul-de-sac sign Tivoli Terrace and a number of other signs around Tramore town.
- Refreshing road markings on the Prom and double yellows placed at Garrus Beach.
- Repair works carried out at the Guillamene swimming area
- Contractor working on the Men's Slip on the Prom to repair storm damaged end.
- There were four out of hours callouts during the month of April 2021 for oil spills.

Dunmore Area

- Velocity Jet Patcher working in Creadan Area.
- Pothole repairs carried out on the L-4079 Drumrusk, L-4080 Ballyvoreen, L-4062 Quilla and the L=96851 at Ballinattin.
- Bin collections are three times a week including weekends due to extra public activity around the towns and beaches in the Area.
- Drainage works and opening inlets on the L-8048 Kilmaquague, the L-8053 Keiloge and the L-40751 Creadan.
- Footpath repairs on the Killea Road at Marian Terrace.
- Ongoing works to footpath in Cheekpoint.
- There was one out of hours callout during April 2021 in Metro East Area for an oil spill.

Waterford City:

- There was drainage works and drainage gullies cleared and repaired at the following locations in April; Cork Road, Cobh Lane, Collins Avenue, The Sycamores, John's Hill, Earls Court, The Forum, The Glean, Peter Street (Taxi Rank) and Summerville Avenue.
- Potholes repaired at Farran Park, Cork Road Estate, Green Street, Lacken Road, Kilbarry, Viewmount, Paddy Brownes Road, The Folly, St Herblain Park, Lauradell, Killure Grove, St John's Park, Ferrybank, Poleberry, Green Road, Kilcohan Park, Manor Hill, The Manor, Gracedieu, The Glen, Clonard Park, Norwood, Earls court, Collins Avenue, Hazelbourne, Ashley Drive, Cherrymount, and Vincent White Road.
- Footpath repairs carried in at Viewmount, The Village, Ballinakill and Clashrea Place.
- Bollards repaired/replaced at Bachelors Walk, John's Hill, Cleaboy Road and Parnell Street.
- Cleaning signs and replacing poles at St. John's Park, Bachelors Walk, Convent Hill, Yellow Road, Ballinakill Park, Ferrybank, Ballygunner, Ballybeg, Mayors Walk, Old Kilmeaden Road, Tramore Road and Templars Hall.
- Cobble repairs at Hazelbourne and wall repairs in Peoples Park.
- There were 11 out of hours emergency callouts in April for issues with faulty traffic lights, oil spills and other roads related incidents. In addition there were also 3 occasions where salting of roads was required in April for Winter Maintenance.
