1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workshop for footpaths, Surface Dressing and strengthening Programme 2022 on the agenda. • Jet Patcher in District as per machinery yard's programme.
2.	<p><u>OPW Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Erosion Risk Management Study in Ardmore as per OPW requirements is ongoing.
3.	<p><u>Coastal Repair Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application for schemes in 2022 will be submitted when requested by Department.
4.	<p><u>TII Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funding applications will be submitted for 2022 following defect survey.
5.	<p><u>CIS and LIS – Round 1 and 2</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CIS schemes and LIS schemes 2022 - pending funding.
6.	<p><u>CLAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CLAR funding 2022 for Villierstown €49,500 and AGLISH €49,500. Works to commence in 2022 when weather is appropriate.

9.	<p><u>Climate Adaption Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application for schemes in 2022 will be submitted when requested by Department.
10.	<p><u>Active Travel</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior Engineer of Active Travel Team will communicate on proposed works for 2022. • Tallow – Construction of footpaths underway including drainage. The remaining section will be completed in 2022 and will commence once weather is appropriate. • Villierstown – when Section 38 is approved, works will be programmed in 2022. • Garranbane –Works completed. Surfacing to follow when trench settlement is sufficient in 2022. • Ballinroad village –Works completed. Surfacing at graveyard in 2022 to allow for trench settlement. • Ardmore – footpath to GAA field – Communications ongoing with landowner. • Knockanore –Footpath works underway including storm drain, removal of EIR cables, installation of public lighting and kerbing. Landtake maps being finalised following discussions with landowners. • Lismore - kerbing and footpath proposal for Deerpark road within proximity of school on works programme and will commence soon. • Ballyduff – Section 38 being finalised in accordance with active travel's requirements.

11.	<p><u>Other works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dungarvan North –Drainage and Road repairs ongoing at Canal road, Lackendarra, Clonea, Dungarvan and Environs. Phase 1 drainage at Lackendarra near completion. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Lismore West –Drainage and Road repair works at Lismore area, Knockanore, Ballyduff area, Glendine area, Ballysaggart area, Kilwatermoy and Tallow area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Lismore East –Drainage and road repair works in Cappoquin Area, Ticknock, Clashmore, Aglish, Dromana, and Melleray area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. • Dungarvan South - Drainage and road repair works underway in Ballybrusa, Liskeelty, An Rinn, Grange and Ardmore area. Gully cleaning and inlet opening ongoing. Traffic Calming works ongoing along R-674 Mweelnahorna.
12.	<p><u>Item Raised/Other Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Road lining ongoing throughout the District. • New public lighting installation at New Lane underway followed by lighting works at Kilgobnet GAA. • Wheelchair assessable table ordered for Ardmore and Dungarvan and will be installed once delivered. • Litter and Dog fouling should be disposed of correctly and we would encourage community groups and public to be involved throughout Towns and Villages. • Spraying is limited in the District and only undertaken where necessary for major weed control. Any communities or groups wishing to assist with weed control would be greatly appreciated. This would reduce spraying. • Hedgecutting is now permitted to end of February. Landowners should continue to check and cut their boundary hedges and trees in particular in front of public roads that may cause road safety issue. Overhanging branches can become a hazard and hedges can cause visibility constraints. • Cycle signs being installed at locations throughout District informing drivers to give cyclist Space – 1.5m and 1.0m as required.
