1.	<p><u>Roads Programme</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surface Dressing and Strengthening programme near completion on local roads in Dungarvan North, Lismore East, Dungarvan South and Lismore West. Surface dressing and Strengthening of Regional Roads underway. • Jet Patcher in District as programme.
2.	<p><u>OPW Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Erosion Risk Management Study in Ardmore as per OPW requirements being finalised.
3.	<p><u>Coastal Repair Works</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applications approved by Department for Dungarvan Harbour Sea wall - €177,032, Baile Na nGall pier - €177,996 and Helvick pier - €340,074. Procurement documents underway.

Drainage works underway at Knockanore and Ballysaggart.
