**Roads Progress Report to end of February 2022**

**1. Road Works Programme**

The Road Works Programme (RWP) for 2022 is being brought to Council for approval this month.

**2. Community Involvement schemes**

We are waiting approval for funding for the CIS scheme for 2022.

**3. Low Cost Safety Schemes**

The funding approval has been submitted for 2022 in the Metropolitan District.

**4. Coastal Repair works**

An application is to be made for 2022 to the Department of Agriculture Food and Marine to approve further funding for coastal repair works at Tramore Pier and in addition funding for works to carry out repairs at Cheekpoint Pier and Passage East have also been included.

**5. Road Closures**

Road closures in Tramore for urban renewal works continued in February.

**6. Other Works**

**Tramore Area**

- Pothole repairs on the R675 (cycle lanes), the L-4007 Dunhill Road, the L-8032 Islandtarsney, at St Otterans Terrace in Tramore, the R680 near Holycross, the L-4044. L-4042 and L-8036 at Lisnakill, the L-4057 Garrus, the L-4052 Ballyclough, the L-4007 Dunhill Road and the R675 Fenor.
- The Jet Patcher was working on repairs on the L-4050 Knockeen, the R675 Waterford Road, the L-4044. L-4042 and L-80236 at Lisnakill/Shangan, the L-96756 Carriglong, the L-80301 Kilfarrassy, the R682 Cullencastle, the L-8036 Sporthouse, the L-4049 Ballycashin and the L-4050 Knockeen.
- Drainage works on the L-80301 Kilfarrassy, the L-4052 Ballynaclog, the R682 Cullencastle/Monvoy and the R675 at Pickardstown.
- Illegal dumping cleared from the R682 near O'Keeffe's Cross.
- Signs replaced at the following locations; Fenor Playground, Main Street Tramore (Loading bay), the L-4048 (junction sign) and the L-675 Pickardstown (no entry sign).
- Other works included some patch repairs on Priests Road and Newtown Road, providing barriers for the duathlon, replacing missing lifebuoy on the Prom, arranging sand bags for Storms (Dudley and Eunice) and also cutting hedges at junctions for sight lines.
- Footpath works on Waterford Road at Corbally and in Riverstown Industrial Estate.
- There were five out of hours callouts during the month of February 2022 for oil spills, a broken Eir pole and issues with storms.

### **Dunmore Area**

- Pothole repairs carried out on the L- 4077 at the Wrens Nest, the L-4080 Ballyvoren, the L-8039 Castletown and the L-4072 Portally.
- Bin collections continue 2 days a week around the towns and beaches in the Area.
- Footpath repairs completed in Woodview Estate in Dunmore East.
- Drainage works and opening inlets on the L-8048 Graigriddy, replacing gully covers in Passage East and side cleaning at Kilmacomb.
- Replacement of signs at Hickeys Cross, Kennel Lane, Woodstown, Kill St Nicholas and on Corbally Road in Dunmore East.
- Ongoing maintenance of sluice valve on Woodstown beach and general clean up after Storms (Dudley and Eunice).
- Two lifebuoys replaced at Woodstown and in Passage East.
- There were two out of hours callout during February 2022 in Metro East Area.

### **Waterford City:**

- There was drainage works and drainage gullies cleared and repaired at the following locations in February; Riverview, Hillview, John Street, Sexton Street, Rockenham, Belmont Heights, St Killians Place, Marymount and Abbeylands.
- Potholes repaired at Nursery Lane, Hawthorn Grove, Hillview, Oak Avenue, Oak Close, Oak Drive, Bishops Court, Ballinakill, Gracedieu East, Cork Road Estate, Larchville, Rockenham, Woodlawn Grove, Dominics Place, Laurel Park, Ashe Road, Avondale Drive/Court, Ursuline Court, Ashbrook Crescent, St Herblain Park, Millers Marsh Car Park, Belvedere Manor, Cleaboy Road and Lacken Road.
- Road signs cleaned, replaced or erected at Carrickphierish Roundabout, O'Connell Street, Outer Ring Road, Connolly Place, High Street, Birchwood, City Centre, Bolton Street Car Park, The Mall, Dominics Place, Morley Terrace, Tramore Road and Ballybeg.
- Footpath repairs carried out in Ashley Court (13 days in February to complete repairs) plus temporary repair in Ferrybank near boys school.
- Bollards repaired/replaced at Michael Street and on the Quay.
- Repairs to wall at Grange Park Avenue – dash to wall.
- Removal of several trees following Storms in February.
- There were 10 out of hours emergency callouts in February for issues with faulty traffic lights, fallen trees during storms, flooding and other road related incidents. In addition there were also 8 occasions where salting of roads was required in February during frosty weather.
