



MATERIAL CONTRAVENTION OF THE TRAMORE LOCAL AREA PLAN 2014 - 2020

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 34 (6) of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Waterford City & County Council intends to consider deciding to grant permission to 36th Waterford & Tramore Bay Scout Group to Build a two-storey, detached Scout Den Activities Building with freestanding climbing tower, car parking, camping and outdoor activities together with associated site development works, including the building of palisade metal boundary fencing and recessed matching entrance gates from the adjoining public road and also the installation of associated services including a connection from the water main, both on adjoining public road at Riverstown, Tramore, Co. Waterford.

The development would contravene materially the following objective of the Tramore Local Area Plan 2014 – 2020:

Industry : To provide for light industry, enterprise and offices

Particulars of the development may be inspected or purchased at the offices of the Planning Department of Waterford City & County Council, Menapia Building, The Mall, Waterford during office hours (9.30 a.m. to 1p.m. and 2p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays).
