



TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, it is proposed to temporarily close the following public roads to facilitate the:

WINTERVAL CHRISTMAS FESTIVAL

- From **6am Sunday 12th November 2017** until **6am Wednesday 3rd January 2018** the following street will be closed for the Winterval Christmas Market:

Arundel Square – L5532 (from its junction with Peter Street to Conduit lane).

Alternative Routes:

All traffic from Patricks Street should divert to The Mall via Lady Lane. Traffic from High Street should divert to The Quays via Conduit lane. A temporary loading bay will be available on Peter Street.

- On **Friday 17th November 2017** from **2pm** until **7pm** the following streets will close for the arrival of Santa Claus and the switching on of the Christmas Lights.

Barronstrand Street – L91092

Broad Street – L91092

Between 4pm and 4:30pm there may be significant delays outbound on The Quay and through traffic should divert either via Ashe Road & Bridge Street or via the N25 (this road is tolled).

Between 4pm and 5:30pm there may be significant delays on Patrick Street, Micheal Street & Peter Street and through traffic should avoid the area if possible.

- From **5am Saturday 9th December** until **11pm Sunday 10th December** the following streets will be closed to facilitate the **All that Glistens - Spraio on the Mall** event.

Bank Lane – L90024

Access to The Mall from Parnell Street and The Quays for PSV Vehicles **only** shall be available from 8:30pm Saturday 9th until 11am Sunday 10th.

High Street – L5533 (from its junction with Olaf Street to Henrietta Street)

Greyfriars – L90020 Resident and car park access will be maintained

Baileys New Street – L90021

Coffee House Lane – L90019

Access to Colbeck Street from Henrietta Street for Taxis and access to Cathedral Close & Christ Church Cathedral for residents will be maintained but at times of crowd pressure (between 4:45pm and 7:30pm on the days above) there will short delays until the crowd has safely dispersed.

Local access for Residents and to Greyfriars car park will be facilitated as much as possible but some restrictions will apply. There will be strictly no parking permitted on the junction of Greyfriars & Chairmans Arch.

- Between the hours of **11am to 8:30pm** on the days above the following shall be closed to facilitate the safe operation of the **Winterval Train & Horse Drawn Sleigh**. All vehicles should use Bakehouse Lane to access Alexander Street.

Michael Street – L1527 (from its junction with Peter Street to Lady Lane).

- Between **11am and 7am from Thursday 16th November 2017** until **Tuesday January 2nd 2018** the area known as **Applemarket** will close to facilitate the hosting of a Christmas Village & Associated Winterval Events.

John Street – L1528 (also known as the Applemarket) From its junction with R680 Johnstown to its junction with L90359 New Street.

To facilitate this closure the following Traffic Management Changes shall come into effect.

- New Street (L90359) shall become two way from its junction with Johns Lane (L90027) to the entrance to New Street Car Park. All traffic for New Street car park shall use this route.
- Traffic Leaving New Street Car park shall egress via New Street and Newgate Street (L9052)
- Traffic for Spring Garden Alley shall enter & egress via Colbeck Street (L90025). This junction will be controlled at the times of highest demand.

There will be no on street parking permitted on New Street during this closure.
