Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 34 (6) of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Waterford City & County Council intends to consider deciding to grant permission to carry out internal alterations to and a change of use from an existing chandlery and fish shop to retain the existing fish shop and include a fish cookery school, delicatessen/ takeaway and cafe incorporating a temporary mobile fully registered EHO approved kitchen , car parking to rear yard and all ancillary site works at The Harbour, Dunmore East, Co. Waterford. The applicant is Elaine Power.

The development would contravene materially the following objective of the Waterford County Development Plan 2011- 2017.
