



RE: SECTION 38 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994 – TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME - LOW COST SAFETY SCHEME WATERFORD ROAD, TRAMORE COMMENCEMENT OF PROCESS

Waterford City and County Council proposes to undertake the construction of a pedestrian crossing and traffic calming measures on the R675 road section between Waterford Road Roundabout (near Apple Green) and Riverstown Roundabout. The proposed scheme will provide continuous shared space for pedestrians and cyclists along both sides of the road between the two roundabouts. This will be delineated using intermittent rubber kerbs to provide additional protection and safety to vulnerable road users.

The proposed works include:

- New Road markings to reduce traffic lane widths to slow down traffic and allow for **3m wide shared surface**;
- Construction of build outs for raised pedestrian crossing;
- Raised pedestrian crossing located between entrance and exit to the AFC car park to consist of a raised table and a flashing beacon (**zebra crossing**);
- A line of **set down only** car spaces outside the soccer club's car park on the main road from the bridge onwards;
- Alteration to entrance and exit to the soccer club car park (revised entrance arrangement to be agreed with Tramore AFC);
- Erecting new bollards with intermittent rubber kerbs to delineate the edge of shared surface.

The drawing is available for inspection on the Council's website www.waterfordcouncil.ie but due to the Covid 19 restrictions will not be on public display in our office buildings.
