



RE: SECTION 38 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994 – TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME AGLISH – ADDITIONAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT WORKS ALONG L-2012/L-2014

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake additional road improvement works along the L-2012/L-2014 Aglish Village. Works will include the continuation of the concrete footpath constructed alongside the properties on the L-2021 Villierstown Road in 2021 and extending southwards as far as the end property at the junction of the L-2012. A 6.0m wide carriageway will be maintained as part of the development works.

Additional connecting widened footpaths will be constructed along the L-2014 Aglish Village with a narrowing of the carriageway to 6.0m wide. Dedicated 2.4m wide parking areas will be provided alongside 'Bothar Na Grann' housing development as set out on the attached drawing.

An uncontrolled pedestrian crossing will be installed adjacent to the existing parking area alongside the Shop/Petrol Station to provide safe movement and connection for pedestrians and cyclists.

These traffic works along the previously constructed footpath and traffic calming works will provide a safe environment for all road users.
