



TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS SECTION 75 ROADS ACT 1993

Notice is hereby given that Waterford City and County Council, in exercise of its powers pursuant to Section 75 Roads Act 1993, will close the following public road to through traffic **from 10am to 5pm on Saturday 3rd September and from 10am to 3pm on Sunday 4th September 2022 to facilitate The All Ireland Road Bowling Championship.**

Road to be closed:

- R675 between Fenor Village and Ballygarran.

Diversion Routes:

- Traffic approaching the R675 (Coast Road) from the Dungarvan direction, divert onto the Ballyheadon Road L4006 prior to Annewstown, then take the L4007 to Dunhill and onto the R683 (Orchardstown to Tramore Regional Road).
- Traffic approaching from Tramore, divert at Newtown Roundabout along the Tramore Ring Road and then take the R682 to Dunhill Cross Roads and L4007 to Dunhill and onto the L4006 to the R675 (Coast Road).
- Local traffic approaching Fenor divert using the L4053 to Ballyscanlan then take the L4052 to the R682, divert onto the Dunhill Road L4007 and L4006 to the R675 (Coast Road).

Note:

- HGV's and Emergency Vehicles will be allowed access through the Road Closure.
- Local Access for Residents will be maintained.
