



# RE: SECTION 38 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994 – TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME ACTIVE TRAVEL SCHEME SHANDON ROAD – NEW FOOTPATHS AND JUNCTION TIGHTENING

Waterford City & County Council proposes to undertake the construction of a new footpath on Shandon Road (L3147) from the N25 roundabout at The Park Hotel to the new pedestrian crossing at Fraher Field. This will include the relocation of accessible parking spaces to the north side of the entrance to Fraher Field. As part of the Active Travel works in the area, the objective is to improve walking routes, improve connections to existing footpaths and create safer crossing points for vulnerable road users.

The drawing is available for inspection on Waterford City and County Council's website [www.waterfordcouncil.ie](http://www.waterfordcouncil.ie) and is also on display in our Customer Services Departments in Bailey's New Street in the City and Davitts Quay, Dungarvan from **Tuesday 20th September 2022 to Monday 18th October, 2022.**

**Scheme Overview**

The scheme proposes a new footpath on the west side of Shandon Road between Shandon Road roundabout and Fraher Field sports ground. Junctions along the scheme will be subject to junction lightening works in line with DMURS and parking restrictions (double yellow lines) will be installed as appropriate.

The existing disabled parking bays on the south side of the main entrance to Fraher Field sports ground will be relocated to the north side of the entrance to the sports ground.

The proposed pedestrian (subject of a previous Section 38 application) crossing on Shandon Road outside of the Fraher Field entrance will also be delivered. Details of the works associated with this pedestrian crossing are shown on drawing AT\_WDCC\_21\_0022\_P5011.

The drawing to the left shows the extent of the proposed footpath scheme.

The drawing below shows the locations of the relocated disabled parking bays to the north of the proposed pedestrian crossing (currently located to the south of Fraher Field entrance on Shandon Road).
